YOUTH WITH A MISSION

**AIM:** Starting a Youth With A Mission (YWAM) University of the Nations (UofN) campus in Calabar (Nigeria) where young people are trained to be the key to transform the nations of West-Africa. Ezekiel 37:1-14

### THE TRIP

Since April 2010 we are following a training period at the "mothercampus" of the University of the Nations in Kona, Hawaii. From April-June 2012 after spending two years away from "home" we are visiting Cameroon, Nigeria and the Netherlands.

### CAMEROON

In Cameroon we spent time with family and friends. Jackson started two water projects with a small team.

The purpose is to provide clean water for a school and a village.

### NIGERIA

In Nigeria we received 4 friends from the US who helped to improve the food production for the campus in Port Harcourt by building a fish pond a piggery.



We had planned to make a trip to Calabar. However after a time of prayer we felt that we should not make the journey due to the unsafety of the roads. We felt the strong leading of the Lord to slow down with the plans for Calabar and to focus on Port Harcourt. When the mothercampus is doing well, then the multiplication to other parts is easy.

Coincidentally (?) YWAM Port Harcourt received an invitation from the government to talk with the Commissioner of Land and Agriculture. This because of the work they had done amongst the former militants. It was exactly at the time we were there and one of our friends who came is the Vice-President of the UofN in Kona Hawaii. So he presented and all of us attended. Jackson was able to give more insight in the food production system he studied in Kona (Ecoconics). That is what interested the Commissioners the most.

Now they are considering the possibility of the government helping YWAM launch the UofN in Port Harcourt by appointing a piece of property. You will hear more about these developments!



For us it has become very clear that we will go to Port Harcourt for a season before spreading out to Calabar.
